

BYOD 2023 iPad Set Up



1.	Check your child's iPad is Gen 8, 9 or 10 (64GB, 128GB, 256 GB)	
2.	Name your child's iPad	
	Name your child's iPad with their name and class. Eg. John C Prep A	
	Settings > General > About > Name	
	Also, write your child's name on the outside of the case.	
3.	Add a Lock Screen passcode All BYOD iPads must have a lock screen passcode. Students must tell their teacher the passcode for their iPad.	
4.	Add a Lock Screen photo of your child's face	
	Adding a photo to the Lock Screen.	
	 Take a photo of your child using the Camera App. Tap the "Settings" icon on your iPad's Home screen to launch the Settings app. 	
	 Tap "Wallpaper" and then tap "Choose a new wallpaper." Select "Camera Roll" and select the photo of your child Select "Select Set Lock Screen" Close the Settings App. 	
5.	Enable-Speak Selection Settings > Accessibility > Spoken Content > Speak Selection (Slide to green = on)	
6.	Turn off- <i>Background refresh</i> Settings > General > Background App Refresh (Slide to grey = off)	
7.	Enable- <i>Dictation</i> Settings > General > Keyboards > Enable Dictation	
8.	Enable-Predictive Text Settings > General > Keyboards > Predictive	
9.	Set your iPad language to English Settings > General > Language & Region > English	
10.	Enable-Dictionary Settings > General > Dictionary > English (UK)	
11.	Disable-Automatic downloads Settings > App Store > Apps, App Updates, In-App Ratings & Reviews, Offload Unused Apps (Select to grey = off)
