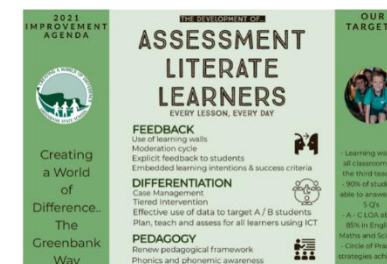




Greenbank State School Creating a World of Difference – The Greenbank Way

YEAR: Year 1 CURRICULUM OVERVIEW – TERM 4 2021



ENGLISH

Students will read fiction and non-fiction books about space and aliens to explore literal and implied meaning of texts. They will answer comprehension questions after reading, using 'right there' in the text information or 'in your head' information and prior knowledge. Students will also create a variety of texts for different purposes such as letters, emails, using punctuation such as capital letters and full stops correctly.

TECHNOLOGY

Students will continue to develop their skills using the Book Creator app and iPads to represent data.

MATHEMATICS

Students will

- Carry out simple addition and subtraction using a range of counting strategies.
- Partition two-digit numbers and represent them in a range of ways.
- Continue simple patterns involving numbers and objects.
- Read and represent time to the half hour and explain time durations.
- Collect data by asking simple questions, draw simple data displays and interpret the data.
- Count and locate numbers on a number line.
- Learn to recognize and describe coins and their value.

HASS

Students will explore natural, managed and constructed features of the school. They will describe and share how places are cared for at home, school and their local environment in the changing world.

SCIENCE

Students will learn about the key features of landscapes and skies during the day and night. They will consider how these features can change and the impact that these changes have on themselves and other living things. Students will do this by sharing ideas with others, drawing their local environments and recording their observations.

HEALTH & PE

Students will examine messages related to health decisions and describe how to keep themselves and others healthy through good eating habits and physical activity. Students will swim each week to develop their skills.

ARTS

Students will explore rhymes and songs as stimulus for music making and responding.
