This funding will be used to

- Deepen early years staff's knowledge and skills in using cued articulation strategies for improved oracy in prep.
- Build the assessment literacy of all students through capacity building of staff in English.
- Improve teacher capability in understanding the curriculum, differentiating content, providing feedback and engaging in rich pedagogy.
- Improve teacher pedagogy in embedding the use of ICTs to support the BYOD program.
- Whole school English AC target 88%, whole school Maths AC target 95%, Whole school science AC target 96%.
- Whole school English AB target 54%, whole school Maths AB target 65%, whole school science AB target 56%.

Our initiatives include


- Creating academic performance teams including a HODC for 3 sectors across the school.
- Closely monitoring students' English progress using ongoing formal and informal data sets.
- Continuing a Case Management approach with targeted students in all year levels focused on Levels of Achievement and improvement.
- Regular cycles of data wall updates and reflection to closely monitor students improvement.
- Enhancing speech therapy support for students at risk across the Early Years.
